

MRI PROSTATE BIOPSY INSTRUCTIONS

You are scheduled for an appointment on:	at	in the
Bernard Mitchell Hospital at 5847 S. Maryland on the 1 st floor in	n the Radiology	Area. At this
time, MRI and MRI guided biopsy of your prostate will be comp	oleted. To prepar	re for your
biopsy, please adhere to the following instructions.		

- Do not take aspirin or any aspirin-like medication for 10 days prior to your scheduled appointment (see side two). If you are taking Coumadin, please stop your Coumadin 5 days before your appointment.
- You will be given a prescription for Cipro 500mg 4 tablets. Please take 1 (one) Cipro 500mg at bedtime the night before your procedure and 1 (one) Cipro 500mg the morning of the procedure. The remaining 2 (two) tablets you will need after the procedure. You will also be given a prescription for Vantin 200 mg. Please take two tablets two hours prior and another 2 tablets 10 hours after the procedure.
- If you take prescription medications on a regular basis, please take them on the day of your examination.
- If you have a same day prostate MRI (morning) and MRI guided biopsy appointment (afternoon), please note that MR guided biopsy appointment in the afternoon is tentative. If your doctor does not identify a target in your prostate MRI, you will not undergo biopsy. You will be notified about this decision around 12 PM. Please leave a number to call you for the results after you complete your prostate MRI.
